- Covers wildfires attended by Fire and Rescue Services during FY2009/10 to 2012/13



Number of GB Wildfires


Number wildfire incidents by Habitat in Finanical Years 2010/11 to 2012/13 in Great Britain attended by Fire and Rescue Services





Area burnt during GB Wildfires


Area burnt of habitats due to wildfire in Finanical Years 2010/11 to 2012/13 in Great Britain attended by Fire and Rescue Services





Duration of GB Wildfires


Duration of wildfire incidents by Habitat in Finanical Years 2010/11 to 2012/13 in Great Britain attended by Fire and Rescue Services






Wildfires impact on EU and UK Nature Conservation and Landscape Designations

Spatial location of wildfires in GB






Woodland Wildfires in GB



Incidences of woodland wildfires by financial year







- +71,000 hectares burnt between FY2009/10 to 2012/13
- +37,000 hectares burnt in FY2011/12
- +211,000 wildfire incident between FY2009/10 to 2012/13
- +65,000 incidents in FY2010/11
- Wildfire incident duration +181,000 hours between FY2009/10 to FY2012/13 or 14 years and 7 months man time
- Wildfire incident duration of +37,000 hours in FY2011/12 or 4 years and 6 months man time
